

Frequently Asked Questions

We design our sheds so that you can make minor modifications when you build to ensure that your new shed really suits your space.



The end door can be installed in either the left or the right wall at the time of the build.

To change the way the door opens, turn this whole wall upside down at the time of build. You may have to drill some extra holes in the top channel (was the bottom) for the roof



Can I have the door on the other end of my shed?


Yes – you simply install the wall with the door, in the end you want. You can make this choice at the time you build. This is a very simple modification.

Can I have the door open right to left instead of left to right?

Yes – you simply install the entire wall with the door upside down. As the pad bolt is mounted as close to the center-point possible, the alignment should be identical. You may have to drill some additional holes in the top channel (was the bottom) for the roof to screw into and reposition the door corner braces. This is an easy modification.


Can I have the roof sloping the other way?

Yes – you simply spin the roof 180 degrees and install the roof around the other way. All the holes should still align. This is a very simple modification.



Assembled sloping left

The roof on skillion roof sheds can be rotated 180 degrees to have the slope go the way you want. Choose this at the time you build.

Frequently Asked Questions


Can I assemble a skillion shed as a flat roof?

Yes – you just omit some panels. You may have to re-drill and cap some holes in the roof sheets. This is a simple modification for a skilled DIY handyman. You cannot assemble a gable roof as a flat roof shed.



Assembled as flat roof


To assemble as a flat roof simply omit the skillion end and infill panels at the time of the build.

Can I fit the shed in my car?

We have designed our packaging to be oneperson lift friendly. Depending on the size of your shed, it will come in either 5, 6 or 9 cartons which each weigh less than 25Kg with grab handles on the side so they are easy to move around. Our cartons are a standard size.



Do you have any colors other than green, cream or zinc?

No – We only have the three finishes. The green is very close to a Colorbond* color called Pale Eucalypt* and the cream is very close to a Colorbond color called Paperbark*. Zinc indicates plain galvanized steel. You can paint a galvanized steel shed to any color you wish with the correct preparation.

*Colorbond and equivalent color names listed are trademarks of Bluescope Steel Limited and are used only for comparison. The use of color names indicates no more than color equivalency.

What tools will I need to assemble my shed?

You only need basic tools. We suggest:

Power screwdriver with Philips head bit plus a spare bit.

Pop rivet gun for assembling the doors. Rivets are all supplied.

Impact drill and 10mm masonry bit for the concrete fasteners.

A 3mm drill bit to clear holes is handy.

Hammer to tap channels into position.

Boxes or saw horses to get things off the ground to save your back.

Small step ladder to help get the roof into position.

Gloves for safety.
